PROGRAM:

Black Sea O-Meeting is an Orienteering competition held over 4 days, from June 18–21. This year, it also serves as the 3rd stage of the National Sprint Championship, organized by the Romanian Orienteering Federation and the Romanian Cup. The competition includes four stages: a Prologue stage in Vadu, then two stages including a Long Distance (LD) race and a Middle Distance (MD) race in Cheile Dobrogei. The final stage is a Sprint race, which will take place in Tăbăcăriei Park in Constanța. Competition maps were surveyed in 2025/2026. Location details in bulletin 2.



COMPETITION AREAS

Cheile Dobrogei	From the perspective of orienteering maps, Cheile Dobrogei is characterized by fragmented karst relief, rich topographic detail, numerous microforms, moderate elevation differences, and alternating visibility, offering ideal technical terrain for middle distance and prologue events, where navigation precision and fine route choice strategies are essential.
Vadu Area	Located near the Black Sea coast, it offers completely different terrain: flat relief, sand dunes, low vegetation, and high-speed orienteering.
Tăbăcăriei Park	An urban area with a dense network of paths, green spaces, and artificial elements, suitable for sprint orienteering according to IOF standards. This stage brings a clear contrast to the natural terrain events and offers conditions comparable to international sprint competitions.

REGISTRATION

AWARDS

Romanian Cup - MD & LD: Top 3 in each category will be awarded.

Black Sea O-Meeting - MD & LD & Sprint (cumulative): Top 3 in each category will be awarded.

National Sprint Championship: The sprint stage being the 3rd of the National Sprint Championship, awards will be presented at the end of the Sprint stages after the final stage taking place at Braşov O-Meeting (November 1, 2026).

ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT
